Joplin, MO – July 26, 2011 – The Information Technology Disaster Resource Center (ITDRC), a non-profit provider of IT disaster support services for the small business community today announced it is accepting donations of computer equipment for distribution to non-profit organizations supporting the Joplin disaster recovery efforts. Equipment can be dropped off through Saturday, July 30 at the Joplin Family Worship Center, 5290 East 7th St in Joplin, MO.

Working laptop and desktop computers, servers, monitors, and productivity software are currently needed by non-profit organizations affected by, and supporting the recovery efforts from the recent tornadoes in the area. All personal information will be securely removed from donated computers, and systems will be refurbished before being distributed to those in need.
